This letter is to inform you of the very high possibility that the electricity and the water will be shut off to the trailer park this Tuesday July 29, 2014, which inevitably shuts down the business of Leahy's Trailer Park. We are sorry to inform you with such short notice but have done everything within our power to keep this business running. We have only now lost hope. This situation is mainly due to MLG&W claiming for the past 5 years that we have a huge water leak somewhere in the park, of which we cannot find. It also has not helped that so many residents have continued to pay their bills late and some were even stealing electricity. We have tried our very best but have fallen so far behind I don't see any way of us catching up. We have gone to MLGW, City Council and even to the Mayor but no one will help us. Also during this time to keep the lights on, Janie and I have gone without pay many times. For me, it has ruined my credit but I'm not important. It's you the resident that worries me most. So even after the utilities are shut off, we will keep the office open as long as possible to help in any way we can in your moving out process. We believe that you 65+ families/residents can make a big impact in this situation. If ALL of you bring this to the City Council, Mayor, MLGW, etc. there may be a chance to at least get an extension for all of you to have time to find another place. We are so sorry this is happening but unless there's a miracle there's nothing we can do to stop it.

Hemos ido al lugar de luz a la ciudad de Memphis y con el Mayor de Memphis y naidie quiere ayudarnos y en este tiempo hemos perdido ayuda de MLGW. Que no nos cortan la luz Janie y yo no nos hemos pagado nuestros sueldos. Me an destullido mi credito, pero no es importante como ustedes. Que es lo que me importa mas y despues de que la luz sea cortada manteneremos la oficina abierta la mas que podamos para ayudarles en situaciones de vivienda. Creemos que las 65+ families y residents pueden aser in impacto en esta situacion. Si todos nos juntamos y llevar esta situacion al estado consular del mayor de Memphis contrar la luz podria ser que nos oyerran y darnos mas tiempo para todos o una extencion. Para darnos tiempo para buscarles otro lugar de vivenda. Lo sentimos mucho que esto no este pasando despues de tantos anos en servicio al la comunidad solamente un milagro tubiera que paser no ay nada mas que podamos aser.
