I, Detective Moses R. Rndriquez 96029, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above named person(s), are the following

On 10-24-16, a burglary occurred at [REDACTED] at approximately 1710 hours. Officer Ryan Kasperson reported that 2 unknown males entered the apartment by unknown means and were captured on video surveillance. During the burglary the suspects stole personal items and jewelry valued at over [REDACTED]

On 10-25-16, Your Affiant met with the victim [REDACTED] and verified the reported facts. At this time Your Affiant also collected video surveillance evidence.


Using the video surveillance data, Your Affiant completed a Crime Stoppers bulletin depicting the two suspects.

On 10-26-16, Your Affiant received an anonymous Crime Stoppers tip that one of the suspects was a "Billy McCaslin" and that he pawns items frequently. Your Affiant researched Pawn records and found a Billy Jack McCaslin (01-26-76). Along with pawn ticket [REDACTED] there was a photo of the suspect dated 09-26-16. Your Affiant immediately recognized the suspect and noted that was wearing the same shirt captured on the video surveillance. The pawn ticket was from "Mister Money #370" located at 9205 Washington St., Thornton, Co.

Your Affiant contacted the pawn shop and spoke with a manger [REDACTED] stated that she recognized the name and was familiar McCaslin. Your Affiant emailed [REDACTED] the surveillance photos of the suspect. [REDACTED] replied back that she was 100% positive that the pictured male was that of "Billy McCaslin". [REDACTED] has known the suspect for over one year.

Based on the aforementioned information Your Affiant respectfully requests Probable Cause Warrant for the arrest of Billy Jack McCaslin (01/26/1976) for Burglary, 18-4-203, Class 4 Felony & Theft 18-4-401, Class 3 Felony

Statement of Probable Cause Affidavit for Arrest Warrant

On 10-24-16, a burglary occurred [redacted] at approximately 1710 hours. Officer Thomas Weis reported that 2 unknown males entered the apartment by unknown means and were captured on video surveillance. During the burglary the suspects stole personal items and jewelry valued at over [redacted]. On 10-25-16, Det. Rodriguez met with the victim [redacted] and verified the reported facts. At this time Det. Rodriguez collected video surveillance evidence. Det. Rodriguez completed a Crime Stoppers bulletin depicting the two suspects. On 10-26-16 Det. Rodriguez received numerous Crime Stoppers tips. One tip was for the named suspect, "Sergio Ireza". Another suspect, Billy McCaslin had already been identified and his work address was at 5701 York St. Det. Mike O'neill went to 5701 York St. and contacted the manager [redacted] was shown suspect photos and he positively identified both McCaslin and Sergio Ireza as the persons in the photos. Having identified Ireza the detectives made an on sight arrest of Sergio Ireza when he returned from lunch. Note that Ireza had not been 100% identified prior going to the York St. address.

At District 3, under Miranda advisement, Ireza admitted to entering the victim's apartment and added that he had the victim's property at his home. This property was later recovered with consent by DPD detectives. Value of theft is approximate [redacted].
