Probable Cause:

On Friday, June 1, 2018, at approximately 2:47 a.m., the Denver 911 Emergency Communication received a call from an adult male witness who said he was near the on-ramp of Interstate 25 at University Blvd. The male caller said there was a guy, an Uber driver, who said his ride tried to attack him and the driver shot him. The male witness described seeing a male slumped down in a silver sedan pulled over on the side of the road. The male caller then handed the phone to the Uber driver who identified himself as Michael Hancock.

Mr. Hancock said he's an Uber driver and that the guy he picked up, attacked him. Mr. Hancock said he was punched in the face and grabbed by the passenger. Mr. Hancock also said the guy was feeling on him. Mr. Hancock then said he pulled over and jumped out of the car. Mr. Hancock also said the guy was reaching for something in his pockets and tried to chase him. Mr. Hancock said he has a concealed carry (permit) and he had to protect himself. Mr. Hancock said the guy was still moving and breathing and asked for an ambulance.

Denver Police Officers arrived on scene and located the adult male witness and a black male, positively identified as Michael Andre Hancock, dob: 07/24/1988, on the on-ramp for southbound I-25, east of University Blvd. The officers also noticed a Nissan sedan stopped perpendicular to vehicle traffic for the on-ramp. The officers approached the Nissan and found an Asian male lying on the floor board of the front passenger seat, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The Asian male was believed to be Hyun Soo Kim, dob: 04/27/1973. The officers began lifesaving measures until Denver Health Paramedics arrived on scene.

Denver Police Officer Christopher Wilcox, 04001, contacted Mr. Hancock and placed handcuffs on his wrists. Officer Wilcox then removed a semiautomatic pistol from the right waist band of Mr. Hancock. The pistol was later determined to be a two-tone Ruger SR 40, serial #34275316. There was magazine in the pistol with four live cartridges. There was no cartridge in the chamber of the pistol. Officer Wilcox removed second magazine and a single live cartridge in Hancock's front left pocket. Mr. Hancock began to have trouble breathing and was transported to DHMC. Mr. Hancock was treated and released from the hospital.

Detective _____

located 10 spent 40 caliber cartridges on the left shoulder of Interstate 25 near University Blvd. Detective Lopez also located a blood trail near the spent cartridges; the blood trail was consistent with the path of where the Nissan sedan came to rest. Detective Lopez noted several suspected bullet strikes in the passenger compartment of the Nissan sedan.

During the autopsy, Forensic Pathologist Dr. Timm, M.D. located several gunshot wounds on the upper right torso of the victim, a gunshot wound on the lower leg, and a gunshot wound on the left wrist.

Mr. Hancock declined to make any statements regarding the shooting incident with out an attorney.

Based on Michael Hancock's statement to the witness, the recovered Ruger pistol, the spent cartridge casings at the scene, and the gunshot wounds on Hyun Kim's body, Your Affiant believes there is probable cause to believe that Michael Hancock discharged the Ruger pistol, striking Hyun Kim numerous times causing his death.
